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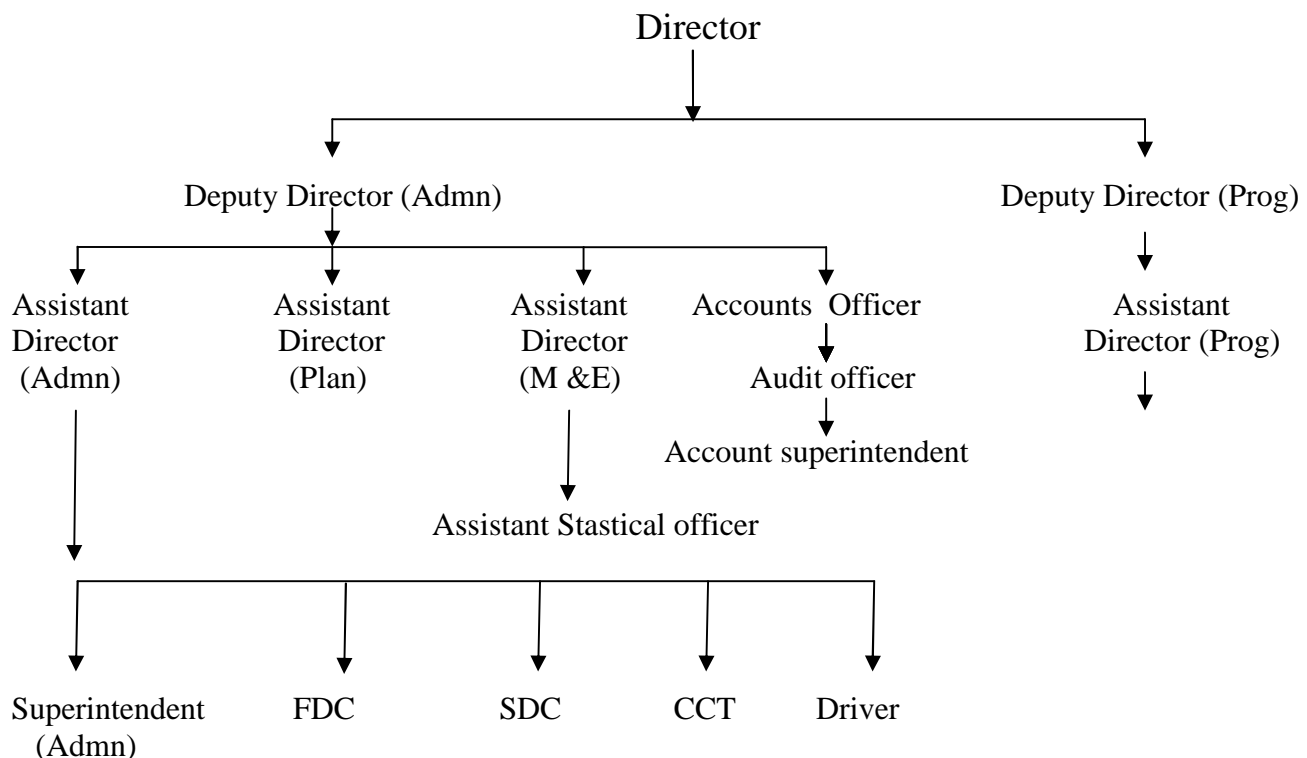
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1) Administrative Structure of Directorate of Mass Education

The Directorate of Adult Education was established in 1978-79 to implement Adult literacy Programme in the State. In 1988-89, the nomenclature was changed as Directorate of Mass Education. The Directorate is implementing Adult Literacy Programmes through Zilla Saaksharata Samithis and Voluntary Organizations. The Directorate provides the necessary guidance and undertakes state-wide monitoring of the programmes. Directorate does not have C&R Rules. Hence, Education Department and other departmental officers and staff were deputed.

1) Literacy Programme in backward taluks as per Dr. Nanjundappa report.

Rs.43.52 lakhs has been sanctioned under the head of account 2202-04-001-0-02-059, which was utilized towards literacy programme in 6 districts of 20 backward taluks as per Dr:Nanundappa Committee report. Under this programme 22318 learners enrolled for learning and 20807 learners completed part III of the primer. Districtwise details are mentioned in Annexure-1.

Special Component Programme (SCP) Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-02-422

A grant of Rs. 55.00 lakhs under this programme is sanctioned & Rs. 27.50 lakh released to KSLMA, as part of the State share of Saakshar Bharath Programme, to implement the literacy Programme for non literates of Scheduled caste community of the age group of 15+ years in 17 districts of the State. Accordingly, the amount has been kept in the KSLMA SB account for basic literacy component of Saakshar Bharat to enable Basic Literacy learning for SC non literates. (Districtwise details are mentioned in Annexure-5).

Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-02-423

A grant of Rs. 25.00 lakhs under this programme is sanctioned & not released.

Vocational Training Programme for Neo-literates:

Rs.80.30 lakhs has been sanctioned under the head of account 2202-04-001-0-03-059, Rs. 75.30 lakhs is utilised for implementation of Vocational Training Programme for neo-literates. 5280 have been completed Part-3. Districtwise details in Annexure-2. Remaining 5.00 lakhs will be utilize towards evaluation during 2014-15.

Special Component Programme(SCP) Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-03-422

A grant of Rs. 50.00 lakhs under this programme is released Rs.45.00 lakhs is utilized for providing vocational training to neo literates belonging to the Schedule caste community of the age group of 15+ years in batches of 20-30 people. Accordingly vocational training programme was conducted for 3140 neo literates belonging to SC community to increase their life skills and improve their economic conditions. Districtwise details in Annexure-3. Remaining 5.00 lakhs will be utilized towards evaluation in 2014-15.

Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-03-423

A grant of Rs. 19.70 lakhs under this programme is released, Rs.17.20 lakhs is utilised for providing vocational training to neo literates belonging to the Schedule Tribe, in the age group of 15+ years in batches of 20-30 people. Accordingly vocational training programme was conducted for 1358 neo literates belonging to ST community to increase their life skills and improve their economic conditions. Districtwise details in Annexure-4. Remaining 2.50 lakhs will be utilize for evaluation in 2014-15.

Saakshar Bharath Programme under General Category.

Saakshar Bharath Programme under the Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-05-101- A grant of Rs. 500.01 lakhs is provided. Out of which Rs. 125.00 lakhs has been released & kept in the KSLMA SB account as State Share under Saakshar Bharat Programme and 121257 Non-literates under general category have been made literate. Districtwise details in Annexure-5.

Special Component Programme under Saakshar Bharat:

Saakshar Bharath Programme Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-05-422 A grant of Rs. 67.46 lakhs is provided. Out of which Rs. 33.73 lakhs has been released & kept in the KSLMA SB account as State Share under Saakshar Bharat Programme and 88805 Schedule Caste Non-literates have been made literate. Districtwise details in Annexure-5.

Tribal Sub-Plan under Saakshar Bharat:

Saakshar Bharath Programme Head of Account 2202-04-001-0-05-423 - A grant of Rs. 37.53 lakhs is provided. Out of which Rs. 16.26 lakhs has been released & kept in the KSLMA SB account as State Share under Saakshar Bharat Programme and 52077 Schedule Tribe Non-literates have been made literate. Districtwise details in Annexure-5.

State literacy rate as per 2001 census was 66.64% Saakshar Bharath Programme is being implemented in rural areas of 18 districts of the state where the female literacy is less than 50%. The districts are Bagalkot, Vijayapur, Bellary, Bidar, Bangalore Rural, Belgaum, Gadag, Haveri, Kolar, Koppal, Chamarajnar, Chitradurga, Mandya, Mysore, Raichur, Tumkur and Kalaburgi. Presently as per 2011 census state literacy rate has been increased to 75.60 % and female literacy rate has been increased by 12 percent.

- Saakshar Bharath is a flagship programme of Government of India implemented jointly with State Government on mission mode comprises of four components of Basic Literacy, Basic Education, Vocational Education and Continuing Education.
- Objective is to make 51.80 lakhs non literates in the age group of 15+ literates.
- Period: to increase literacy rate to 80% by the end of mission period 2014 March.
- In the 1st slot, the programme is sanctioned for 16 districts, 97 taluks and 3170 Gram Panchayaths.
- In the 2nd slot, 07 taluks and 220 Gram Panchayaths of Gulbarga district has been sanctioned.
- In II Phase the target of 12.00 lakhs Basic Literacy Programme has started in all 17 districts 113 Taluks and 3390 Gram Panchayaths.
- The Central and State share of the programme cost is 75:25

Implementing Agencies

For the implementation of Saakshar Bharath Programme, following committees have been constituted and Bank accounts opened.

- KSLMA, General Council and Executive Committee 20 districts, 117 taluks and 3788 Gram Panchayath Lok Shikshana Samithis are constituted and their respective bank accounts have been opened.
- For the implementation of programme, 5 state co-ordinators, 80 district co-ordinators, 117 block co-ordinators and 7303 gram panchayat preraks are identified and trained.
- The programme was formally launched in Karnataka on 07.08.2010 by Hon'ble Chief-Minister.
- The programme was launched in all districts, taluks and Gram Panchayaths during the period 08.08.2010 to 15.08.2010.
- Household survey is completed in 3788 Gram Panchayaths of 20 districts and around 73.66 lakhs non literates have been identified.
- To enable learning under Basic Literacy, 22 lakhs primers "Balige Belaku" and 2 lakhs teachers guide "Bodhakara Kaipidi" have been printed and distributed to Gram panchayats and Learning Centres. Teaching learning materials have been procured and distributed in 18 districts.
- To enable continuation of learning by learners who have completed basic literacy primer, 8.20 lakh copies "Bridge Primer" – Saakshar Deevige have been printed and distributed to AECs of Gram Panchayaths and Learning Centres.
- To enable continuation of II Phase learning under basic literacy 13 lakh primers 'Balige Belaku' and literacy primers 5.5 lakh copies of Bridge-primer, Saakshara Deevige and 1.20 lakh Teachers guide 'Bodhakara Kaipidi' have been printed and distributed to all Gram Panchayath and learning centres.

Primer based and Management Training and Learning Centers

- 592 Resource Persons and 13223 Master Trainers have been given primer based training.
- Management training given to Co-ordinators and Preraks.
- In 1st Slot 2999371 Volunteer teachers have been trained in 20 districts and learning centres have been functioned.
- In 2nd slot 87345 learning centres are functioning

- 860966 Number of Non-literates have completed basic literacy primer

Environment Building

- Posters, Banners, folders, handouts, Stickers are used for publicity of programme.
- To ensure publicity to the programme, Song and Drama division of Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has held 62 special publicity programme by way of Kalajathas in 3 districts of Belgaum, Vijayapur and Kolar. On 27th & 28th February 2012, a 2 day orientation work shop held for the artists.
- Street Play, Kala Jatha, Cycle Jatha have been held in most of the villages of 16 districts for literacy Environment Building.
- Saakshar Bharat Nation Wide Yatra was held in partnership with BGVS in 5 districts of Vijayapur, Bidar, Raichur, Koppal and Kalaburgi in February 2012.
- Health camps, cultural programmes have been held in select AECs

Monitoring

- Monthly review meetings were held for periodic monitoring
- District Nodal Officers are appointed for every district to monitor the programme.
- Based on the reports of Nodal officers, specific need based guidance is given to districts.

Assessment/Examination for Neo-literates.

Under Saakshar Bharat Programme, Assessment Examination conducted for neo-literates with the co-ordination of NLMA and NIOS for Basic Literacy on 24.08.2014 in 17 districts, 3390 GPs wherein 233850 neo-literates appeared for exam and 185710 neo-literates have passed. On 15.03.2015 in 17 districts, 3390 GPs wherein 533879 neo-literates appeared for exam & result is awaited.

Uploading on Saakshar Bharat Web portal:

On the Saakshar Bharat web portal hosted by NIC, all information pertaining to constitution of SLMA, 16 districts, 97 blocks and 3170 Gram Panchyat Lok Shikshan Samithis have been uploaded. Similarly details of 64 district co-ordinators, 97 blocks co-ordinators and 6340 preraks are uploaded. Household survey has been conducted in all Gram Panchyat and all details of non literates and voluntary teachers who will be running the learning centres is being made visible on the web portal for world-wide consumption. This availability of information of the programme on

cyberspace brings in transparency and greater visibility in the implementation of the programme.

Fund and Accounts Management System:

Under Saakshar Bharath Programme Fund and Accounts Management System, a web-based system, has been developed by (NLMA –CDAC) for the implementation of the programme, all accounting transactions of the main account and subsidiary accounts of 17 districts, 107 blocks and 3507 Gram Panchyats are being uploaded to bring in greater and better transparency, accountability Financial Management, which will enable effective monitoring of utilisation of funds.

Model AEC Centers:

In the year 2014-15, 55 AEC centres were updated as model AEC's. Contained Corporator India Ltd., New Delhi. 50.00 lakhs for provided infrastructure 20 model AEC's and Power Finance Corporation Ltd., has sanctioned 87.50 lakhs for other 35 model AECs respectively. The infrastructures such as T.V. Computer, UPS & Printer, Reading Tables with chairs, Almirah, DVD Player, Fan, Jamakhana, Generator.

Awards:

On the Eve of International Literacy Day held on 12.09.2014, 39 awards (both cash prizes and certificates) were honoured to District/Taluk/Gram Panchayat Lok Shikshana Samithis Officers, Field personnel and volunteer teachers of districts worked under various literacy programmes.

Hon'ble President of India has conferred "**Best Gram Lok Shikshana Samithi**" of Saakshar Bharat 2014 award to **Doddagattiganabbe**, Gram Panchayath Lok Shikshana Samithi, Hoskote Taluk, Bangalore Rural District for successful implementation of Saakshar Bharat Programme on International Literacy Day held at New Delhi on 08.09.2014 by the Ministry of Human Resource & Development, Govt. of India.

Dissolved Karnataka State Adult Education Council:

Karnataka State Adult Education Council was implementing some literacy programme and it was dissolved in the year 2001. Thereafter, the entire system has come under the Administrative Control of Directorate of Mass Education. Out of 16 vidyapeethas established under this dissolved committee, in 13 working vidyapeethas are working. For rural educated unemployed youth in the age group of 18-35 years were provided Vocational Training in Modern Courses such as Dress making, Basic Computer course and others, remaining 3 vidyapeethas are not working due to lack of basic needs. In the year 2014-15 out of a target of 488 youths enrolled for this course, 433 youths have completed training in Ist phase. In IInd phase out of 502 youths enrolled, 469 youths have completed. Vidyapeethas wise details in Annexure-6.

Other Details:

1. Public Grievance Cell:

There is a public grievance cell in the directorate. First Saturday of every month is observed as public grievance day. Applications/grievances are received and attended to at the earliest.

2. E-Governance:

There is a separate E-Governance section. The Directorate's website is created and updated. All the DAEO office have BSNL broad band internet facility. The Directorate and DAEO offices have Internet connectivity. Information about the different programmes in the districts is received through the e-mail. Information from the directorate is sent to the DAEO office similarly.

3. Karnataka State Literacy Mission Authority:

Karnataka State Literacy Mission Authority is a registered autonomous body. Hon'ble Chief Minister is the Chairperson of General Body and Hon'ble Minister for Mass Education is the Vice-Chairperson of the General Body. The Chief Secretary to Government is the Chairperson of the Executive Committee and Principal Secretary to Government (Primary & Secondary Education) is the Vice-Chairperson of Executive Committee of KSLMA. It is an apex literacy body for funding and monitoring of literacy programmes in the state. The Director of Mass Education is the Member Secretary for both the committees.

Right to Information Act:

As per RTI Information Act 2005 department details 4(1) (A), 4 (1) (B) are uploaded in web portal.
